IN CASE OF A HURRICANE

Advance preparations

- 1. Plan your escape route.
- 2. Take pictures or make a video of your property and valuables.
- 3. Protect property trim trees and landscaping to prevent wind damages.
- 4. Stock an emergency supply kit with extra water and nonperishable food items.
- 5. Check your insurance coverage and make sure policies are hurricane-ready.

Two - Three Days before landfall

- 1. Secure buildings and board windows.
- 2. Bring loose items inside lawn chairs, trash cans, hanging plants, etc.
- 3. Stay tuned to local radio or television stations. (Have a battery operated radio or TV in emergency supply kit.)
- 4. Set refrigerator to coldest setting.
- 5. Fill up bathtubs, sinks, and other containers with clean fresh water.
- 6. Park car as close to a building as possible if not in a garage.
- 7. Fill gas tanks for evacuation travel.
- 8. Get emergency cash.
- 9. Protect important documents in water-proof containers.
